Huntington disease is a hereditary, neurodegenerative illness with physical, cognitive and emotional symptoms. About one in every 7,000 Canadians has HD, but one in every 1,000 is touched by HD, whether at risk, as a caregiver, family member, or friend. The HD gene is dominant, which means that each child of a parent with HD has a 50% chance of inheriting the disease and is said to be at-risk. To date, there are no drugs to slow or stop the progression of HD; however, there are specific drugs available to reduce some of the symptoms. Research is being conducted in Canada and globally to find promising treatments and approaches to treating HD. A case of 12 Amaryllis is \$204.00; each individual Amaryllis is \$17.00.
